**Subject:** L.7. Staff Report (For Possible Action): Resolution No. \_\_\_\_\_ Resolution donating Council Donation Funds to the Concerns of Police Survivors (C.O.P.S.) to support their mission and service to families of law enforcement officers killed in the line of duty in the amount of \$250. (General Fund)

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**Summary:** Councilmember Paul McKenzie would like to allocate \$250 from Council Donation Funds assigned for Fiscal Year (FY) 17/18 to the Concerns of Police Survivors (C.O.P.S.), a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization, to support their mission which provides resources to assist in the rebuilding of the lives of surviving families of law enforcement officers killed in the line-of-duty.

**Financial Implications:** Funds are budgeted for Council Donations in the General Fund.

**Legal Implications:** NRS 268.028(1) states that the governing body of a city may make donations to nonprofit organizations created for religious, charitable or educational purposes to be used for a selected purpose. The donated funds must be used to provide a substantial benefit to the inhabitants of the city. Council approval is required before the recommended funds transfer can take place.

**Recommendation:** Staff recommends Council adopt Resolution No. \_\_\_\_\_ and approve the request to allocate a Council Donation to the Concerns of Police Survivors (C.O.P.S.) in the amount of \$250.
