Subject: L.3. Staff Report (For Possible Action): Resolution No. _____ Resolution donating Council Donation Funds to the Food Bank of Northern Nevada to support their mission to feed the hungry and solve hunger for tomorrow through community partnerships in the amount of \$500. (General Fund)

Summary: Councilmember Oscar Delgado would like to allocate \$500 from Council Donation Funds assigned for Fiscal Year (FY) 17/18 to the Food Bank of Northern Nevada, a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization, to support their mission to feed the hungry and solve hunger for tomorrow through community partnerships.

Financial Implications: Funds are budgeted for Council Donations in the General Fund.

Legal Implications: NRS 268.028(1) states that the governing body of a city may make donations to nonprofit organizations created for religious, charitable or educational purposes to be used for a selected purpose. The donated funds must be used to provide a substantial benefit to the inhabitants of the city. Council approval is required before the recommended funds transfer can take place.

Recommendation: Staff recommends Council adopt Resolution No. _____ and approve the request to allocate a Council Donation to the Food Bank of Northern Nevada in the amount of \$500.
