Subject: **B.16. Staff Report (For Possible Action): Approval of the Subgrant Agreement with the Nevada Division of Environmental Protection to the City of Reno to reimburse 25 percent of the replacement costs of four snow plow dump trucks and a bucket truck in an amount not to exceed \$271,419. (Reimbursement to Fleet Management Fund)**

Summary: This Subgrant Agreement from the Nevada Division of Environmental Protection (NDEP) is for reimbursement to the City of Reno for the purchase of four snow plow dump trucks and a bucket truck.

Discussion: The NDEP has received Diesel Emission Reduction Act funds that focus on improving air quality and reducing pollution. NDEP is offering up to \$271,419 to reimburse the city for 25 percent (including the outfitting) of the replacement costs of four 2002 snow plow dump trucks and a 2001 bucket truck. The replacement of these five vehicles will reduce emissions while providing more uniformity to the city fleet.

Council approved the purchase of this equipment as part of the FY20 Fleet Buy Program on September 11, 2019. Acceptance of this agreement will increase the city's ability to purchase additional replacements of vehicles in subsequent years.

Financial Implications: The City of Reno will receive reimbursement up to \$271,419 from the NDEP to the Fleet Management Fund.

Legal Implications: The agreement provides for reimbursement to the City for 25 percent of the replacement costs, including outfitting, of five vehicles within the city fleet.

Recommendation: Staff recommends Council approve the Subgrant Agreement for Reimbursement to the City of Reno.

Proposed Motion: I move to approve staff recommendation.
