

Top Accomplishments in FY19/20

Major Initiatives and Strategies for FY20/21



• Top Accomplishments

- Implemented and secured funding for a Fire Apparatus Replacement Program for the next 10 years.
- Received an Assistance to Firefighters (AFG) SAFER grant to fund eight new firefighter positions for three years in the amount of \$1.9 million dollars.
- Increased our total daily front-line paramedic response units to eight; which averages about two paramedic companies per year since the inception of our paramedic program in 2016.

• Major Issues and Strategies

- Develop a plan to increase staffing to mitigate the negative affects high call volume has on the health and wellness of personnel and provide the highest level of service to Reno. *(Public Safety)*
- Expand Advanced Life Support (ALS)/Paramedic medical program by adding additional paramedic apparatus. *(Public Safety)*
- Continue to develop and research funding strategies and grant opportunities with the goal of developing a systematic replacement program to address the needs of replacing/remodeling our aging fire stations. *(Identify New Revenues)*
